 - Specific curriculum
 - Each student attends this class once a week

- Initial Findings
 - Lack of growth in Reading from 3rd to 4th grade
 - 33% of students showed growth from Mock test
 - Greatest number of students showing decline-3rd graders who scored Masters level in 3rd Grade declined in 4th grade
- Possible Solutions
 - Increase time and motivation for independent reading in 4th grade
 - More targeted enrichment for higher performing students
 - Begin tutorials earlier in the year
 - Improved curriculum awareness and fidelity

• Other

- Student Attendance- Griffith receives highest attendance rate often
- Staff Attendance 2019- 97.6%
- Learning Environment- Less discipline referrals this school year
- Parent survey- Suggestions -training for parents to be more involved with their children at school
- Outside Funding- Last year obtained 2 grants
 - Dow Grant for Outdoor Learning Lab
 - Education Foundation Grant for VR Glasses for instruction
- Karen shared the activity account balances as well as the PTO and Hospitality account balances with the committee and went over the expenditures
