• Accountability Review

- Karen shared the Griffith Star Score Comparisons
 - Griffith earned a TEA Distinction
 - Griffith improved scores overall
 - System safeguards met 24 out of 24
 - Graded above state averages in all categories

• Review of Campus Improvement Plans

- Karen reviewed last year's goals with the committee
- District goals
 - Percentage of students reading on grade level will increase from 71% to 100% by 2020

- Percentage of students in grade 3 and 4 who perform above the state passing standards in reading and math will increase from at or below state level to 10 percentage points above the state level by the year 2020
- o Campus Goals for 2017-2018 School Year
 - 90% of Pre K students will be Kindergarten ready by the end of the year
 - 90% of Non ELL and 80% of ELL Kindergarteners will be on grade level by the end of the year
 - 92% of Non-ELL and 75% of ELL 1st Grade students will be reading on grade level by the end of the year
 - 90% of Non-ELL and 80% of ELL 2nd Grade students will be reading on grade level by the end of the year
 - 80% of 3rd grade students will score at the "Approaches" level on the 2018 Reading and Math STAAR tests
 - 80% of 4th grade students will score at the "Approaches" level on the 2018 Reading and Writing STAAR tests.
 - 87% of 4th graders will score at the "Approaches" level on the 2018 Math STAAR test
- Other Campus Goals
 - 97% student attendance rate
 - 95% staff attendance rate
 - Student use of technology in 60% of BTAS walk-throughs
 - 5% decrease in discipline referrals that result in ISS/OSS
 - Teachers apply for grants
 - Greater Community involvement
 - Thank you to Platinum Marketing for purchasing bilingual books for our Literacy Picnic
 - Wayfind Assessment improve teacher scores on technology knowledge
 - To have all students reading on grade level by 2020
 - Continue to increase student and staff growth goals each year
